**Western leg of nationals proved productive for
Team Royal Distributing Motovan Piller's Racing presented by Huber
Motorsports**



Royal Distributing Motovan Piller's Racing presented by Huber Motorsports' Tyler Medaglia finished the western leg of the Rockstar Energy Drink Motocross Nationals, with another solid MX1 ride on Sunday.

Thanks to 4-4 moto results at Moto Valley Raceway in Regina, Saskatchewan, Medaglia snared fourth overall, keeping his feet firmly planted in the top-five points standings as the series heads east.

Medaglia's teammate, Kyle Chisholm, claimed sixth overall on the strength of 8-5 motos, ensuring a seventh place in the current points standings. Nathan Bless continued to hold his own, squeezing out a

top-10 finish for himself with 10-10 moto results. He currently sits 11th in the points.

The start of the first moto did not look promising for Medaglia, who was recorded in 15th place, after one lap, while Chisholm was holding down eighth and Bles 10th. That would all change when Medaglia sliced and diced his way forward to fifth place aboard his potent black Honda CRF450R over the next 13 laps. To add the icing on the cake Medaglia snatched fourth place on the final lap, finishing behind winner Matt Goerke, second place Christophe Pourcel, and third place Mike Alessi.

Chisholm and Bles were two of the riders who caved to Medaglia's charge towards a top-five finish. Chisholm dropped back as far as 11th place, after his eighth place start, to chisel his way back into ninth and then on to an eighth place finish, which he pulled out of the bag on the final lap.

Bles held onto his 10th place finish for most of the moto, even briefly moving up to eight, to eventually end up back in 10th towards the end of the race and secure that position at the checkered flag.

The start of the second moto saw all three teammates out of the gate with a top-10 start, of which Chisholm led the trio into turn 1 holding down fifth, Medaglia sixth, and Bles eighth. By the halfway point of the moto Chisholm had moved into fourth, with Medaglia following suit to take over fifth. Bles found himself in 10th by this time, a position he would hold until the finish line.



Up front, meanwhile, Goerke was chasing down holeshooter Mike Alessi, sticking a pass on him on lap 9. Around this time Medaglia traded positions with Chisholm, passing his teammate for fourth. A few laps later the Florida native was cruising in sixth while Medaglia had dropped one position back to fifth.

On the final lap, it looked like Medaglia and Chisholm would have to take satisfaction with those positions, but that was going to change quicker than a New York minute. Just a few corners before the finish line a rock derailed Goerke's chain, opening the door for Pourcel, who had also stuck a pass on Alessi earlier on, to take over the lead.



With Goerke's departure from the top-five, Alessi inherited second place, Dillan Epstein third, Medaglia fourth and Chisholm fifth. Goerke somehow managed to contain the damage by getting his bike going again just in time to still salvage sixth at the finish line.

All in all, Team Royal Distributing Motovan Piller's Racing presented by Huber Motorsports can look back on their first ever western leg of the MX1 Motocross Nationals campaign with the satisfaction of holding down one top-five spot in the current points standings, with Medaglia in fourth, and one top-10 with Chisholm in sixth. Bles, currently in 11th place, is just five points shy of 10th.

After a two-week break in the schedule, the Rockstar Energy Drink Motocross Nationals resume for the eastern leg of the title hunt on Sunday, July 9th at Gopher Dunes in Courtland, ON.

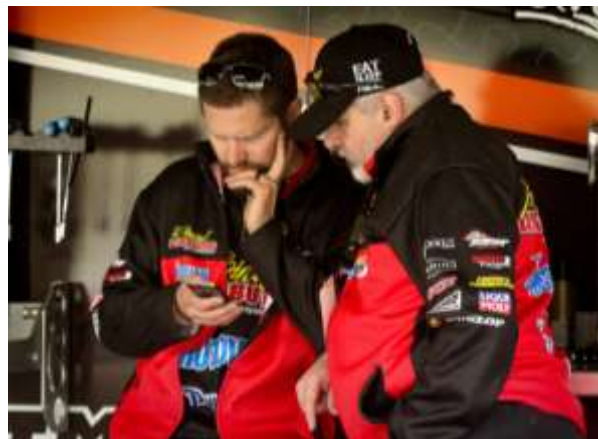

To this day, after five generations of sausage makers, Piller's still uses the same natural aging, curing, and smoking process that had customers lining up outside Wilhelm Huber's butcher shop over 60 years ago. The company was acquired by Premium Brands Holdings Corporation in 2011 and is now known as Piller's Fine Foods.
