THOR - KAWASAKI - PRO CIRCUIT RACE REPORT

August 9, 2021

MX Deschambault hosted round 6 and 7 of the 2021 Triple Crown Series this past weekend. Riders from across Canada competed in multiple classes on KX65, KX85, KX250/450.

The team traveled from our race shop in Breslau Ontario to Deschambault Quebec on Wednesday and unloaded the transport truck and set up the pit area to prepare for the E-Can armature event that would run Thursday through Saturday. We provided support during the event for all Kawasaki riders.

Dylan competed throughout the week in the 85-class sweeping both the 85 class and 112 supermini class going 1-1-1 for the championships. Dylan also raced in the 125- schoolboy class going 3-2-2 for second overall.

On Sunday, we raced round six of the Triple Crown Series and round seven was a one moto format on Monday.

Darian had a great start in moto 1 and completed lap one in 1st place where he battled back and forth during the race ended in 2nd. Darian got another great start in moto 2 and was able to capture the win but was tied on points after going 2-1 and ended up 2nd overall.

Monday, Darian focused on starts and track conditions and worked his way into the lead and got another win for 1st overall for the day. Darian now has moved into 3rd in the series points, just 7 points out of first with the final motocross round August 15th. The team will continue working on giving Darian the best motorcycle possible to compete for the championship at Walton Raceway.

Marshal had a good start in moto one Saturday and was able to challenge for the win eventually finishing in 2nd. Moto two was a great start, but on lap one another rider hit Marshal from behind causing him to crash putting him outside the top 10. Marshal gave 110% effort working back to 4th which would give him 3rd overall on the day.

Monday, Marshal got another good start and worked himself into 2nd at the finish which was 2nd overall for the day. He is now sitting 3rd in the championship only 6 points out of 2nd.

As we approach the Walton Trans Can race, please save the date Friday August 13th. At 6 pm we will host a Kawasaki rider appreciation dinner for all our Kawasaki family members.
