THOR - KAWASAKI - PRO CIRCUIT RACE REPORT

September 7, 2021

Gopher Dunes hosted round 3 and 4 of the 2021 Triple Crown Series this past weekend. This was the last weekend of racing and points battles were close in both classes. Riders from across Canada competed in multiple classes on KX65, KX85, KX250/450.

On Friday, Dylan crashed in practice and sprained his thumb. To prevent further injuries, the team kept Dylan from racing, and he will focus his attention on being healthy for the last few rounds of the Canadian AMO series. He will then be heading to the USA to compete in the Florida Mini Olympics in November.

Darian had great qualifying times on Friday, and it was very exciting when he finished 2-3 for 3rd overall gaining even more points heading into the final round only 2 points behind the championship leader.

Saturday, Darian qualified 2nd and after another fabulous start and worked his way into the lead and finished 1st. Going into the final race Darian had a 5-point lead in the championship and road a smart race finishing 2nd. This then gave him 2nd overall for the day and the Triple Crown Championship along with the Supercross championship.

Marshal has been dealing with a shoulder injury this season that kept him from competing in the final round. He will head back to the USA to have the injury medically evaluated and prepare for next season. Marshal finished the season 2nd overall in the Triple Crown Championship this year winning races and becoming the team leader.
